

TOURNAMENT RULES

This is a pool play into single elimination tournament.

1. All teams must have insurance, ASA, USSSA, etc.
2. UMPIRES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL. No protests. ASA rules will be followed.
3. The HOME team is the official scorekeeper.
4. TIME LIMIT: 7 innings or 1 hour and 30 minutes. Pool play games will finish the inning after expired time. Time limit will be in effect for all games except the Championship Game, the Championship game will be 7 innings or run rule.
5. Coin flip before game determines HOME team for all games.
6. Pool games can end in a tie if time is expired or 7 complete innings have been played.
7. International tie breaker rule will be used in tournament play.
8. RUN RULE: 12 after 3, 10 after 4, and 8 after 5 innings of play. Run Rule is in effect for
9. Championship games as well.
10. THE WINNING TEAM is responsible for notifying Tournament Headquarters of final score immediately after the game. **NO SCORE REPORTED RESULTS IN A 11-11 TIE!**
11. Coaches must check bracket boards and maintain contact with Tournament Headquarters in case of time changes. Game times and changes will be posted on our web page: www.gillettefastpitch.com.
12. COURTESY RUNNER -A Substitute MAY COURTESY RUN for the pitcher and/or catcher. If there is no substitute, there is not courtesy runner. Courtesy runner may not run for both the pitcher and catcher in the same inning.
13. Saturday's pool play results will determine seeding into a double elimination tournament on Sunday and Monday. In the event of a tie in pool, seeding will be based off the following:
 - a. Win/Loss Record
 - b. Head to head score
 - c. Runs allowed
 - d. Coin flip (Only games in your pool count in seeding.)
14. In case of rain, tournament director may change the format and/or number of games in
15. order to complete the tournament. If NO games are played, all but \$75 of the
16. entry fee will be refunded.
17. Have your FIRST AID KITS available in the dugout when playing games.
18. Please clean up your dugout after each game.
19. Top winner of each division will receive medals.
20. Please send your roster information with your team name, coaches, players with uniform numbers. If you do not have this information at the time of registration, please send it as soon as it is available. To: **Terry Sjolin, P.O. Box 1393, Gillette, WY 82717**

21. Guest players are allowed with proof of governing registration, and are age appropriate for the division in which they will be playing. Age of birth Jan. 1st, 2017.
22. Birth certificates or USA pictured ID card, in case of a roster challenge. Not being able to prove birth dates if roster is challenged will result in your team being removed from the tournament and loss of tournament entry fees.
23. Game balls are provided.
24. Bicentennial Park allows dogs, sunflower seeds, and gum.
25. Sunflower seeds gum, and dogs *are not* allowed are Energy Sports Complex.
26. No alcoholic beverages at either complex.

**NO sunflower seeds or Gum in Energy
